Enabling them to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ identify hazards associated with both the job and the work environment,▪ increase levels of risk perception,▪ identify the measures needed to control the risks,▪ monitor the work to see that the PTW requirements are being followed, and▪ ensure that the job is left safe at the end of the day.
